Facilitating international trade

We understand import/export regulations, particularly as they relate to international trade and technology transfers. Andrews Kurth has represented many clients in Section 337 International Trade Commission proceedings involving antidumping, infringement and tariff-related matters. We also advise on Section 301 provisions of the U.S. Trade Act, and on the World Trade Organization's (WTO) procedures for enforcing intellectual property rights.
